List A.L.S. 1 of 1981**

APPLICATIONS are invited for 138 farms in Copper Queen Central Section, which is situated approximately 100 kilometres north-west of Gatooma. The sizes of the farms vary, but each is planned to give approximately 30 hectares of arable land and grazing for at least eight livestock units.

The farms will be available initially on a two-year probationary lease. This probationary period may be extended. Thereafter, acceptable settlers will be offered leases containing an option to purchase their farms.
