APPRENTICESHIP TRAINING AND SKILLED MANPOWER DEVELOPMENT ACT [CHAPTER 266]

Preliminary Notice: Motor Industry: Amendment of Conditions of Apprenticeship

IT is hereby notified, in terms of subsection (4) of section 16 of the Apprenticeship Training and Skilled Manpower Development Act [Chapter 266], that the Minister of Manpower Planning and Development proposes to amend the provisions of Rhodesia Government Notice 655 of 1975.

The purport of the amendment is to-

- (a) discontinue the phasing system of apprenticeship in the Motor Industry and reduce the period of indenture to four years;
- (b) withdraw the provision for a remission of portion of the indenture period of apprentices who had completed a period of national service;
- (c) provide that apprentices, whether indentured under the old phasing system or the new system, who are considered to be sufficiently advanced in their trade, may, after passing a competency test, complete their apprenticeships after three years;
- (d) introduce provisions for the cancellation of an apprentice's contract of apprenticeship if he should fail to pass—
 - (i) a progression test after twelve months, if he has not commenced his college training; or
 - (ii) the examination at the end of the second term of college training; or
 - (iii) a progression test which is to be undergone by any apprentice who should fail to pass the Zimbabwe National Craft Certificate examination.

A copy of the notice embodying this proposal is open for inspection at the office of the Registrar of Apprenticeship.

- (a) a notice, in writing, of his intention to object, so as to reach the Controller's office not later than the 3rd April, 1981; and
- (b) his objection and the grounds therefor, on form R.M.T. 24, together with two copies thereof, so as to reach the Controller's office not later than the 24th April, 1981.

Any person objecting to an application for the issue or amendment of a road service permit must confine his grounds of objection to matters directly bearing on the considerations referred to in paragraph (a), (b), (c), (d), (e) or (f) of section 8 of the said Act.
