#### PLANT PESTS AND DISEASES ACT [CHAPTER 128]

#### Extension of Growing-period: Tobacco Other Than Oriental

IT is hereby notified that the Minister of Agriculture has, in terms of section 5 of the Plant Pests and Diseases (Tobacco) Regulations, 1979, exempted all owners and growers from compliance with the provisions of paragraph (b) of section 4 of those regulations in respect of tobacco-plants of the current season, the reaping of which has not been completed before the 1st May, 1983.

Pursuant to the provisions of section 108 of the Constitution of Zimbabwe, and to provisions of the Ombudsman Act, 1982 (No. 16 of 1982), the Ombudsman is now in a position to receive complaints in respect of aggrieved persons who, in the case of individuals, are citizens or residents of Zimbabwe, or, if dead, were such citizens or residents at the time of death, or, in any other instances, carries on business or activities in Zimbabwe. Subject to any extension of time that may be granted by the Ombudsman, a complaint will only be entertained in terms of the said Act if it is made within a period of twelve months from the date when the acts complained of first came to the notice of the complainant.

Complaints must be lodged in writing, and should provide details of the complainant's name, address and occupation, together with particulars of the respondent. The substance of the complaint and the nature of the relief sought should be specified clearly. Where possible, complaints should be accompanied by certified true copies or photo-copies of all relevant documents. The staff of the Ombudsman are available to advise and assist complainants who are illiterate or are not able to write out their complaints and those who experience difficulties in obtaining documents to substantiate their complaints.

It is further notified that any person who is detained in terms of the Mental Health Act, 1976 (No. 23 of 1976), may complain to the Ombudsman, and the complaint must be forwarded to the Ombudsman without alteration or comment.
