REGIONAL, TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT,
1976Notice of Minister's Decision on the Beitbridge Local Plan
No. 1

IT is hereby notified, in terms of subsection (3) of section 13 of the Regional, Town and Country Planning (Master and Local Plans) Regulations, 1977, that the Minister of Local Government and Town Planning has approved the Beitbridge Local Plan No. 1, subject to the following conditions—

- (a) that all future low-cost/high-density housing development in Beitbridge conforms with housing policies and guidelines with regard to minimum stand sizes, housing type and design, and mode of construction, as specified from time to time by the Ministry of Housing; and
- (b) that the secondary school be developed on land to the north of and contiguous to the existing Dulibazimo Primary School and not on either of the two secondary school sites depicted on Plan BF134/2.

- (a) the Instructions Relating to the Drafting and Typing of Legislation (Attorney-General's Circular 1 of 1978); and

- (b) the Manual of Style for the Drafting and Preparation of Copy, published by the Department of Printing and Stationery;

which two booklets are intended for complementary use.

In these conditions, other than where a particular kind of copy is specified, "copy" means copy for all matter contained in the *Gazette* itself and for subsidiary legislation issued as supplements to the *Gazette*.

1. (1) Other than by prior arrangement, only original typing is accepted.

(2) Carbon-copies are not normally acceptable, other than in cases where the original typing has to be legally retained elsewhere, as, for example, in the case of a proclamation.
