### SCHEDULE

#### MEMORANDUM OF AN AGREEMENT

made and entered into by and between

**THE STANDARD BANK PUBLIC LIMITED COMPANY**, a company incorporated in England with limited liability, and having its registered and head office at 10, Clements Lane, London, EC4N 7AB, England (hereinafter referred to as "the seller"), of the one part, and

**STANDARD CHARTERED BANK ZIMBABWE LIMITED**, a company incorporated in the Republic of Zimbabwe with limited liability, and having its registered and head office at Harare, Zimbabwe (hereinafter referred to as "the purchaser"), of the other part.

WHEREAS the seller carries on the business of banking in the Republic of Zimbabwe;

AND WHEREAS the seller wishes to sell its business in Zimbabwe to the purchaser.

NOW, THEREFORE, these presents witnesseth that the parties hereto have entered into and concluded the following agreement, that is to say:

1. That this agreement shall be conditional upon the happening of the following events by not later than the 30th day of September, 1983—

- the grant by the Minister of Finance, Economic Planning and Development in the Government of the Republic of Zimbabwe of written approval hereof in terms of section 17 of the Banking Act [Chapter 188], of the laws of Zimbabwe (hereinafter referred to as "the Banking Act");
- the registration of the purchaser as a commercial bank under the Banking Act;
- the designation of the purchaser as an authorized dealer under the Exchange Control Regulations, 1977, of the Republic of Zimbabwe.

2.1 That, subject to the fulfilment of the conditions afore said, and with effect from the 1st day of October, 1983, the seller hereby sells and agrees to transfer to the purchaser, and the purchaser hereby purchases and agrees to take transfer from the seller, of the whole of the seller's banking and other business (including executor and trustee business) as carried on in and from Zimbabwe at the 30th September, 1983, including

the property, assets, interests, benefits, privileges, rights, obligations, duties and liabilities of every description appertaining thereto, including any situate outside Zimbabwe, but exclusively employed in or exclusively appertaining to the business of the seller in Zimbabwe (hereinafter referred to as "the said business"), all of which shall vest in the purchaser from the 1st day of October, 1983.

2.2 That, for the removal of any doubt, it is recorded that the shares held by the seller in certain companies in Zimbabwe, as listed in the Schedule hereto annexed, do not form any part of the said business.

3. That the purchase-price of the said business shall be the book value thereof (exclusive of hidden reserves) as determined by the seller's auditors in Zimbabwe as soon as possible after the 30th September, 1983, and such purchase-price shall be discharged by the allotment to the seller or its nominee on the 1st day of October, 1983, of seventeen million (17 000 000) shares of one dollar (\$) each, fully paid up, in the capital of the purchaser and by the credit to the share premium account in the books of the purchaser of the balance of the purchase-price.

4. That, without derogation from the generality of the provisions of clause 2 hereof, and with effect from the 1st day of October, 1983—

4.1 all agreements, appointments, nominations, transactions and documents made, entered into, drawn or executed by, with or in favour of the seller in respect of or arising from the said business and in force immediately prior to the 1st day of October, 1983, shall remain of full force and effect and shall be construed for all purposes as if they had been made, entered into, drawn or executed by, with or in favour of the purchaser;

4.2 any bond, pledge, guarantee or other instrument to secure advances, facilities or services, whether already made or provided, or to be made or provided, in respect of or arising from the said business shall remain of full force and effect, and shall be construed for all purposes as a bond, pledge, guarantee or instrument, as the case may be, given to or in favour of the purchaser as security for such advances, facilities or services made or provided, or to be made or provided, by the purchaser;

4.3 any appointment or right held by the seller immediately before the 1st day of October, 1983, whether alone or jointly with any other person as trustee, executor, administrator or in any other fiduciary capacity shall, on and after the 1st day of October, 1983, be held by the purchaser, whether alone or jointly with such other person, in the same capacity upon the trusts, and with and subject to the powers, provisions, liabilities and obligations applicable thereto respectively;

4.4 any reference to the seller in any deed, instrument or other document, whether or not the seller was a party thereto, and whether executed before, on or after the 1st day of October, 1983, relating to the said business or to acts, duties or obligations to be performed in Zimbabwe by the seller shall, for the purpose of any act, matter or thing to be performed or to become operative on or after the 1st day of October, 1983, be deemed to be a reference to the purchaser, which shall be entitled and obliged to recognize, honour or otherwise deal with all acts, duties and obligations to be performed thereunder as if reference to the seller were a reference to the purchaser;

4.5 no action, arbitration or other proceedings, extra judicial or otherwise, then pending by or against the seller in relation to the said business shall in any wise be prejudiced or affected by reason of this agreement, and the purchaser shall be substituted as a party thereto in place and to the exclusion of the seller;

4.6 any licence, exemption, permit, appointment, certificate, mandate or authority held by the seller in terms of any law or otherwise in respect of the said business shall be deemed for all purposes to be held by the purchaser;

4.7.1 any person who is an employee of the seller immediately before the 1st day of October, 1983, and who is not—  
(a) as at the 1st day of October, 1983, under notice of dismissal or resignation; or  
(b) to remain an employee of the seller by arrangement between the seller and the employee prior to the 1st day of October, 1983;

shall, on and from the 1st day of October, 1983, become an employee of the purchaser on terms and conditions of service not less favourable than his pre-existing terms and conditions of service with the seller, and such employment with the seller and with the purchaser shall be deemed for all purposes to be a single continuing employment;

4.7.2 a reference to the seller in any trust deed or rules constituting or relating to any pension scheme or provident or superannuation fund established in Zimbabwe of which persons employed by the seller are members shall, on and from the 1st day of October, 1983, be construed and have effect as if the same were a reference to the purchaser of which such persons become employees under paragraph 4.7.1, but so that, for the purposes of ascertaining and calculating any right to benefit under such scheme or fund, continuous service with the seller prior to the 1st day of October, 1983, shall be taken into account as if it were service with the purchaser;

4.7.3 the operation of any provision of this paragraph shall not of itself give rise to a claim by any person under any scheme or fund such as is mentioned in paragraph 4.7.2 hereof.

5. That it is recorded that section 17 of the Banking Act applies to this agreement, and that accordingly the assets and liabilities comprising the said business vest in the purchaser without further deed or document. However, should any asset not vest as aforesaid, the seller undertakes to do whatever shall be necessary in order to effect such vesting as soon as possible after the 30th September, 1983, and if so requested by the purchaser the seller shall give to the purchaser such powers of attorney, assignments of rights of action or other adequate and proper authority as the purchaser may require in order to enable it to enforce any claim or right of action arising from this agreement.

6. That the seller shall make available to the purchaser, as at the 1st day of October, 1973, all records and books relating to the said business.

7.1 That the tangible assets comprising the said business are transferred to the purchaser as they stand without warranty against defects, patent or latent, and subject to whatever reservations, restrictions, covenants, leases, agreements and encumbrances there may be thereover.

7.2 That the risk in all the assets comprising the said business shall pass to the purchaser on the 1st day of October, 1983.

8.1 That where before, on or after the 1st day of October, 1983, any person dies or has died domiciled in Zimbabwe leaving property in Zimbabwe (with or without property elsewhere) and a will executed before, on or after the 1st day of October, 1983, which appoints or purports to appoint the seller, whether alone or jointly with any other person or persons, to be the executor and/or administrator and/or trustee thereof, such will shall be construed and have effect as if any reference therein to the seller was to the purchaser.

8.2 That where before, on or after the 1st day of October, 1983, any person dies or has died domiciled outside Zimbabwe leaving property in Zimbabwe and a will executed before, on or after the 1st day of October, 1983, relating exclusively to property in Zimbabwe which appoints or purports to appoint the seller, whether alone or jointly with any other person or persons, to be the executor and/or administrator and/or trustee thereof, such will shall be construed and have effect as if any reference therein to the seller was to the purchaser.

8.3 That, for the purpose of this clause, "will" shall include any codicil or other testamentary instrument.

9.1.1 That the purchaser undertakes to make suitable arrangements for its employees who are members of The Standard Bank Limited Zimbabwe Pension Fund to continue to be accorded membership of that fund with benefits on retirement as expressed in the current rules of that fund.

9.1.2 That the purchaser undertakes during such time as members of The Standard Bank Limited Pension Fund are in the employ of the purchaser, to pay to the local account in Zimbabwe of The Standard Bank Limited Pension Fund the monthly pension contributions which the seller would have paid on behalf of such members had they remained in the employ of the seller.

9.1.3 That the seller, in consideration of the purchaser making such contributions, undertakes to make suitable arrangements for employees of the purchaser who are members of The Standard Bank Pension Fund to continue to be accorded membership of that fund with benefits on retirement as expressed in the current rules of that fund.

9.2 That the seller undertakes to arrange and do or have done all that may be necessary to transfer the powers to appoint, remove and fill vacancies in the trustees of The Standard Bank Limited Zimbabwe Pension Fund to the purchaser.

9.3.1 That the purchaser shall ensure that existing pensioners receiving pensions from The Standard Bank Limited Zimbabwe Pension Fund continue to receive such pensions as if no transfer of the afore-said business had been made.

9.3.2 That the seller shall ensure that existing pensioners receiving pensions from The Standard Bank Limited Pension Fund continue to receive such pensions as if no transfer of the afore-said business had been made.

10. That the purchaser hereby indemnifies the seller from and against all claims, loss or liability which may be made upon it or which it may incur in consequence of the failure by the purchaser to meet any obligation transferred by the seller to the purchaser in terms of this agreement or in consequence of any right which any employee of the seller may have against the seller arising out of his transfer to the purchaser.

11.1 That the seller and all persons authorized by the seller shall, for a period of one (1) year, terminating on the 30th September, 1984, have free access at all reasonable times during business hours to all books, papers, records and documents relating to the said business (save for books, papers, records and documents relating to the affairs of any individual customer of the purchaser) as show or relate to the affairs of the seller or may otherwise be requisite for enabling the seller to obtain any information or particulars concerning its said business and undertaking or to enable the seller to comply with any statutory requirements.

11.2 That the seller undertakes, upon receipt of a written request by the purchaser, at any time, to furnish all such details and information as the purchaser may require relating to the said business.

12. That the parties hereto shall as soon as possible enter into an agreement for the provision by the seller to the purchaser of such advisory, technical and other services as shall be required by the purchaser.

13. That this agreement shall be interpreted and take effect according to the laws of the Republic of Zimbabwe.

14. That the purchaser shall bear all the costs of the registration, preparation and execution of this agreement and its implementation.
