Water Restrictions

- (a) for any consumer supplied with water by Harare Municipality to use hose-pipes or sprinklers, including micro-jet systems, attached to a water mains supply for the watering of lawns, gardens, sports-fields or tennis-courts, or for the washing of motor-vehicles, patios or yards, or the topping up of swimming-pools or ornamental ponds; and
- (b) to empty and subsequently refill an existing swimming-pool using water supplied by Harare Municipality.

Exemptions

The following uses and users of water are exempt from the provisions of the above scheme.

1. The use of hose-pipes or sprinklers for fire-fighting purposes.
2. Registered market gardens or nurseries which are, and have been, habitual users of water supplied by Harare Municipality for the purposes of growing vegetables or flowers as a full-time business. (Market gardens or nurseries presently dependent on bore-holes as the source of water for their business operations will not be allowed to use water from municipal mains in the event of their bore-holes drying up.)
3. Persons whose business it is to construct swimming-pools are permitted to fill newly constructed pools once only.
4. Persons whose business it is to construct or repair tennis-courts are permitted to use hose-pipes connected to the municipal water mains to supply such water as is necessary to effect satisfactory construction or repair.
5. Such uses and users which may be approved by the council in particular cases of hardship or in the public interest.

Explanatory note.—The water-restriction scheme introduced in May, 1983, banned the use of hose-pipes by domestic water consumers. Although a significant fall in water consumption has resulted, the target of 208 Ml per day has not been realized. The revised scheme, set out above, extends the ban on the use of hose-pipes for certain purposes to all consumers, including industrial and commercial concerns, schools, sports clubs and Government offices. It also bans the emptying and refilling of swimming-pools, and the topping up of swimming-pools and ornamental pools with hose-pipes.

In these conditions, other than where a particular kind of copy is specified, "copy" means copy for all matter contained in the *Gazette* itself and, for subsidiary legislation issued as supplements to the *Gazette*.

1. (1) Other than by prior arrangement, only original typing is accepted.

(2) Carbon-copies are not normally acceptable, other than in cases where the original typing has to be legally retained elsewhere, as, for example, in the case of a proclamation.
