Renewal of Road Service Permits

HOLDERS of road service permits which are due to expire on the 31st January, 1984, are reminded that applications for renewal thereof must be lodged, on form R.M.T. 8, with the Controller of Road Motor Transportation, P.O. Box 8332, Causeway, not later than the 1st January, 1984.

Subsection (2) of section 9 of the Road Motor Transportation Act [Chapter 262] provides that the Controller shall not consider any application for the renewal of a road service permit unless it is lodged with him at least 30 days before its date of expiry

 - (b) the costs of transfer, including conveyancer's charges, stamp-duty and any other fees; and
 - (c) all arrear rates and charges, and any other expenses necessary to complete the transfer.
