**WATER ACT, 1976****Notice of Reservation of Public Water: Mukwadzi River**

THE Minister of Energy and Water Resources and Development, in terms of subsection (1) of section 66 of the Water Act, 1976, hereby reserves for an indefinite period for future use the first uncommitted 365 million cubic metres of the annual runoff of the catchment area of the Mukwadzi River, at the site of the proposed Mazwikadei Dam, approximately 18 kilometres upstream of the confluence of the Hunyani and Mukwadzi rivers, after due allowance for all rights to the use of public water extant on the 11th November, 1983, and after an additional allowance, for future use in the upper catchment



area of the Mukwadzi River, of 16,24 million cubic metres of the runoff of the said catchment area. The additional allowance for future use equates to approximately 10 per centum of the mean annual runoff of the catchment.

Includes private dwellings used by one family only, or buildings with a maximum of seven rooms. Properties containing two dwelling-houses, each supplied through its own meter, only to be assessed as two domestic consumers if rent is paid for the second dwelling.	800 litres per day.
<b>Non-domestic and flats: Tariff XOA</b>	
Includes—	
(a) Flats . . . . .	500 litres per day.
(b) Municipal installations, that is, municipal offices, depots, stores, etcetera.	70 per cent. of the average water consumption over the past six months.
(c) Commercial properties, that is, shops, hotels, boarding houses, offices, sports clubs and other properties used for residential purposes which are served through a bulk meter.	70 per cent. of the average water consumption over the past six months.
(d) Industrial consumers, including factories, bakeries, dye works, the National Brewery, etcetera.	80 per cent. of the average water consumption over the past six months, with the proviso that industrialists whose process requirements would be seriously prejudiced by such a ration be permitted to apply to the council for special consideration.
(e) Government installations, that is, government offices, schools, hospitals and all government properties.	70 per cent. of the average water consumption over the past six months. Clinics, hospitals and doctors' surgeries not to exceed their October, 1983, water consumption.

The council has further decided that any consumers who exceed their ration shall pay a surcharge, at the rate of \$5 per kilolitre, and that a restriction disc shall be inserted in the meters of those consumers who exceed by double the amount of their water ration.

**Note—**

- The ration will be enforced on the basis of the metre-reading period, that is, the period between consecutive meter readings. This means that where meters are read every two months, double the monthly ration will be permitted for, two-month period, the surcharge being applied to the *actual* reading month account. In the case of the Western suburbs, where meters are read quarterly, a similar principle will apply over a three-month period.
- One cubic metre = 1 kilolitre = 1 000 litres = 220 gallons.

The success of the rationing scheme will depend on the positive co-operation of the public to conserve water. The support of the public in this respect is, therefore, earnestly sought.

#### Conditions for Acceptance of Copy

FAILURE to comply with any of the following conditions will result in the rejection of copy, and no responsibility can be accepted if such rejection should affect any date contained in such copy or any requirement of publication on a specific date.

Persons drafting any kind of notices are strongly advised to follow the guidance offered in—

- the Instructions Relating to the Drafting and Typing of Legislation (Attorney-General's Circular 1 of 1978); and
- the Manual of Style for the Drafting and Preparation of Copy, published by the Department of Printing and Stationery;



which two booklets are intended for complementary use.

In these conditions, other than where a particular kind of copy is specified, "copy" means copy for all matter contained in the *Gazette* itself and for subsidiary legislation issued as supplements to the *Gazette*.

1. (1) Other than by prior arrangement, only original typing is accepted.

(2) Carbon-copies are not normally acceptable, other than in cases where the original typing has to be legally retained elsewhere, as, for example, in the case of a proclamation.

(3) Computer print-outs are not accepted automatically, as discussion may be necessary with regard to the extra time and costs involved.

2. (1) All copy must be clear and legible, and there must be double or one and a half spacing between the lines.

(2) Any corrections or alterations made by the originator must be clearly effected in blue or black ink:

Provided that any copy containing extensive alterations will be rejected.

3. (1) Copy must appear on one side only of each sheet of paper.

(2) Except as is provided in subsection (2) of section 8, paper must not exceed 210 millimetres in width.

(3) If copy comprises two or more sheets of paper, all sheets must be numbered consecutively, in arabic figures, preferably in the top right-hand corner.

(4) Where any matter is added after the copy has been prepared, and such additional matter results in one or more sheets being inserted between those already numbered, all sheets must be renumbered from there onwards — not, for instance, 7, 7a, 7b, 8, et cetera.

4. Photographic copy or copy produced on a duplicating-machine may be accepted if it is abundantly clear.

5. (1) Should any copy—

(a) exceed 10 pages of double-spaced typing on size A4 paper; or

(b) contain tabular or other matter which involves complicated setting;

it will be classed as "lengthy" copy, and will be required to be submitted not less than 21 days before the date of closing for the *Gazette* in which it is to be published.

(2) Lengthy copy may be accepted at less than 21 days' notice if—

(a) the work involved is of a straightforward and non-tabular nature; and
