TRADE MEASURES ACT [CHAPTER 298]

Assizing: Goromonzi, Marandellas, Mrewa, Mtoko, Mudzi, Seki and Wedza Districts

NOTICE is hereby given, in terms of subsection (1) of section 15 of the Trade Measures Act [Chapter 298], that all persons having measuring equipment in use in trade in the Goromonzi, Marandellas, Mrewa, Mtoko, Mudzi, Seki and Wedza districts are required to produce the same to an inspector for the purpose of their being assized on or before the 18th May, 1984, at any of the assize stations specified in the Schedule at the appropriate time specified opposite thereto.

Failure by any person to comply with the provisions of this notice, unless exempted in terms of the Act or regulations made thereunder, renders him liable to prosecution and to the penalties specified in the Act.
