BANKING ACT [CHAPTER 188]****Variation of Minimum Holding of Liquid Assets: Registered Commercial Banks and Registered Accepting Houses**

CITY OF MUTARE

Emergency Scheme for Restricted Use of Water

NOTICE is hereby given, pursuant to the provisions of section 134A of the Urban Councils Act [Chapter 214], that the Commissioners of the City of Mutare have, because of the fall in storage level of the Odzani Dam (Lake Alexander), resolved that an emergency scheme for the restricted use of mains water supplies by all consumers be introduced with effect from, and including, Friday, 20th July, 1984, until further notice.

The use of furrows for irrigating gardens; the use of hose-pipes and sprinklers for watering gardens is strictly prohibited. This prohibition applies to the whole of the Council area, its environs and includes the incorporated areas of Dangamvura and Sakubva.

Any person contravening this prohibition will be guilty of an offence.

In terms of section 267 of the said Act, any person guilty of an offence shall be liable to a fine not exceeding one thousand dollars, or in the case of continuing offence, for more than fifty days, to a fine not exceeding twenty dollars for each day during which the offence has continued.

We further appeal to all consumers to conserve water supplies by—

1. Ensuring that all plumbing is watertight and that leaks are repaired promptly.

2. Reporting immediately any leaks in the public water reticulation system.
3. Repairing all leaks in ponds, swimming-pools, filtration plants, etc. (when backwashing filters, ensure that as little water as possible is used. Swimming-pools should not be emptied and water should only be added to keep the level of the pool to the minimum required.)
4. Reducing the amount of water in all cisterns by carefully placing a brick or similar object in the cistern. This applies to both automatically and manually operated cisterns. Consult a specialist for advice, if necessary.
5. Shutting down automatically operated flushing devices during non-use periods, at night or over weekends.
6. Using showers wherever possible and using minimum water in the bath.
7. Washing hands and hair, etc., in plugged hand basins and not under running taps and using some receptacle when washing teeth and not letting the tap run.
8. Re-using water wherever possible and avoiding all non-essential uses.
9. Displaying "save water" notices distributed by the City Engineer, prominently in bathrooms in all establishments.

Remember, voluntary restrictions now will reduce the severity of compulsory measures that will have to be introduced if there is not a dramatic improvement in rainfall shortly.

which two booklets are intended for complementary use.

In these conditions, other than where a particular kind of copy is specified, "copy" means copy for all matter contained in the *Gazette* itself and for subsidiary legislation issued as supplements to the *Gazette*.

1. (1) Other than by prior arrangement, only original typing is accepted.

(2) Carbon-copies are not normally acceptable, other than in cases where the original typing has to be legally retained elsewhere, as, for example, in the case of a proclamation.
