CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ACT [CHAPTER 177]**Trade Agreement with the Republic of South Africa: Preferential Duty Certificates**

ATTENTION is drawn to the provisions of Article 5 of, and to Parts IV, V, VI and VII of Annexure B to, the Trade Agreement between the Government of Zimbabwe and the Government of the Republic of South Africa, published in Rhodesia Government Notice 811 of 1964, for certain quantities or values of specific goods manufactured in Zimbabwe to be imported into the Republic of South Africa at preferential rates of duty, for quota periods commencing on the 1st January, 1985.

Each South African customs bill of entry referring to goods imported in terms of the above provisions must be accompanied by the relevant certificate. The procedure for obtaining certificates is outlined hereunder.

Clothing specified in Part IV of Annexure B

Any manufacturer wishing to obtain an allocation for clothing specified in this Part should apply to the Zimbabwe Clothing Council, which makes such allocations and issues individual certificates. Certificates issued by the council are countersigned by, or on behalf of, the Secretary for Trade and Commerce.

Other Goods Requiring Certificates

Any manufacturer who wishes to obtain an allocation for the quota period commencing on the 1st January, 1985, for other goods requiring certificates (these goods are specified in the Schedule to this notice) should apply to the Secretary for Trade and Commerce, Private Bag 7708, Causeway, not later than the 7th December, 1984.

Information which must accompany applications

The following information must be given in each letter of application—

- (a) name of applicant;
- (b) address of applicant;
- (c) description of goods for which allocation is sought;
- (d) South African tariff heading;
- (e) allocation requested (quantity and value);
- (f) present annual production of goods concerned (quantity and value);
- (g) present annual capacity of goods concerned (quantity and value).

Notes:

1. Attention is drawn to the special provision for Zimbabwe content, as set out in the agreement.
2. Allocations will be expressed in terms of value, for duty purposes, as laid down in the South African Customs and Excise Act, 1964.
3. Certificates will be valid for two months from the date of issue, provided that certificates issued during the last month of the allocation period will be valid only until one month after the end of that period.
4. If an allocation is not taken up in full, it may be reduced by the appropriate amount in the following period.
