ROAD MOTOR TRANSPORTATION ACT [CHAPTER 262]

Applications in Connexion with Road Service Permits

IN terms of subsection (4) of section 7 of the Road Transportation Act [Chapter 262], notice is hereby given that the applications detailed in the Schedule, for the issue or amendment of road service permits, have been received for the consideration of the Controller of Road Motor Transportation.

Any person wishing to object to any such application must lodge with the Controller of Road Motor Transportation, P.O. Box 8332, Causeway—

- a notice, in writing, of his intention to object, so as to reach the Controller's office not later than the 26th September, 1986;
- his objection and the grounds therefor, on form R.M.T. 24, together with two copies thereof, so as to reach the Controller's office not later than the 17th October, 1986.

Any person objecting to an application for the issue or amendment of a road service permit must confine his grounds of objection to matters directly bearing on the considerations referred to in paragraph (a), (b), (c), (d), (e) or (f) of section 8 of the said Act.
