INLAND WATERS SHIPPING ACT [CHAPTER 258]

Notice to Mariners (No. 1 of 1988)

IT is hereby notified that, in terms of subsection (1) of section 141 of the Inland Waters Shipping Regulations, 1971, the following instructions are issued to mariners—

Inland waters: Crew quarters on vessels

1. (a) All vessels engaging a crew, whether permanently or not, shall provide on board accommodation for such crew;
- (b) the dimensions of the crew quarters shall be related to the size of the vessel, the number of crew employed and the nature of the vessel's services;
- (c) the crew quarters shall be of an acceptable minimum standard—
 - (i) entrance/exit readily accessible;
 - (ii) adequate ventilation under all conditions;
 - (iii) fitted with standard size beds/bunks and bedding;
 - (iv) fitted with storage lockers.
- (d) adequate lavatory facilities shall be provided in a separate compartment.
2. Vessels engaging a crew to perform work during the hours of darkness only shall—
 - (a) be exempted from the requirements of paragraphs (a), (b) and (c) of section 1;
 - (b) in addition to the requirements of paragraph (d) of section 1, provided a weatherproof shelter with seating and storage space.
3. Vessels of less than 9 metres in length over all, that are engaged in short cruises during the hours of daylight only, and returning to base for the night are exempted from the requirements of sections 1 and 2.
4. Vessels unable to comply with the above requirements shall be deemed unsuitable to engage a crew.

INLAND WATERS SHIPPING ACT [CHAPTER 258]

Notice to Mariners (No. 2 of 1988)

IT is hereby notified that, in terms of subsection (1) of section 141 of the Inland Waters Shipping Regulations, 1971, the following instructions are issued to mariners—

Inland waters: Right of way

All vessels manoeuvring in restricted waters and vessels which, due to their size/draught or disability to manoeuvre in accordance with the collision regulations and are restricted to deep channels for safe passage, shall have right of way over all other traffic.

Note:

1. A vessel leaving a harbour has right of way and any entering traffic shall stand off till it is safe to proceed.
2. If a vessel is manoeuvring within a harbour, berthing, all other traffic shall avoid creating a close quarters (collision) situation.
3. Fairways and deep-water channels shall be entered left, or crossed at right angles as much as possible.
4. All vessels should navigate to their Starboard side of a restricted waterway as close as is safe to do so, bearing in mind that large vessels may only be able to navigate in mid-channel.
5. All vessels manoeuvring upstream on rivers shall give way to vessels navigating in the opposite direction (going downstream).
6. Harbours and rivers shall be entered on the correct side of the entrance by crossing the fairway at right angles well clear of the entrance and proceeding at the Starboard side of the channel.
