ROAD MOTOR TRANSPORTATION ACT [CHAPTER 262]

Renewal of Road Service Permits

HOLDERS of road service permits which are due to expire on the 31st January, 1990, are reminded that applications for renewal thereof must be lodged, on the form R.M.T. 8, with the Controller of Road Motor Transportation, P.O. Box 8332, Causeway, not later than the 31st December, 1989.

Subsection (2) of section 9 of the Road Motor Transportation Act [Chapter 262], provides that the Controller shall not consider any application for the renewal of a road service permit unless it is lodged with her at least 30 days before its date of expiry.

All holders of road service permits which expire in January, 1990, are hereby notified that, in terms of section 8 of the Road Motor Transportation Act [Chapter 262], the holders of such permits are required, when submitting applications for the renewal of their permits, to substantiate the rate of utilization of each permit during the entire period of validity ending in December, 1989. Exemption from Non-Residents' Tax on Interest

THE Minister of Finance, Economic Planning and Development, in terms of subparagraph (iv) of paragraph (a) of the definition of "interest" in subparagraph (1) of paragraph 1 of the Sixteenth Schedule to the Income Tax Act [Chapter 181], hereby specifies the Agricultural Marketing Authority in respect of interest payable by the Authority on the loan provided for by the acceptance credit facility entered into on 21st November, 1989, between the Authority and a syndicate of banks, and with Bankers Trust Company acting as agent for the banks. The loan is guaranteed by the Government of Zimbabwe for US45 million.

The consequence of this specification is that the interest payable on the said loan is exempt from non-residents' tax on interest.

STATUTE LAWS COMPILATION AND REVISION ACT, 1986

Introduction of Loose-leaf System of Statutes

IT is hereby notified, for public information, that the statute law of Zimbabwe will be published in a loose-leaf binder system consisting of 15 volumes containing the statutes and one volume consisting of a General Index to the Statutes. Publication will be in three stages. It is intended that the first five volumes will be published in January, 1990. The remaining volumes will be published at six-monthly intervals thereafter, in batches of five volumes, after the publication of the first five volumes.

The cost of the full set of 15 volumes of statutes, together with the sixteenth volume of the General Index, will be about \$1500. This amount will include the cost of supplying replacement pages which update the statutes to include all amendments made prior to the 31st December, 1990.

The statutes contained in the loose-leaf system will be as revised in terms of the Statute Laws Compilation and Revision Act, 1986. In terms of section 53 of the Constitution they will be the sole and authentic version of the laws of Zimbabwe.

Any person who wishes to purchase the 15 volumes of the loose-leaf system of statutes should notify the Law Revisor as soon as possible of that fact and of the number of sets he requires. When the first five volumes are ready for publication, a purchaser will be required to pay \$500 before taking delivery. Thereafter he will have to pay \$500 for each additional set of five volumes. As only a limited number of sets of satutes will be printed, persons wishing to purchase one or more sets are advised to notify the Law Revisor in writing of their requirements as soon as possible.

The statutes will be kept continuously up to date by means of service issues showing new legislation and amendments to existing legislation. Replacement pages will be prepared and made available for sale by the Government Printer. However, any person who is registered as a subscriber to the loose-leaf system will be supplied automatically with replacement pages as soon as they are prepared. The cost of this service will be notified in due course. Persons who wish to be registered should apply in writing to the Law Revisor as soon as possible.
