NATURAL RESOURCES ACT [CHAPTER 150]

Declaration of Vuti "F" Intensive Conservation Area:
Hurungwe District

IT is hereby notified, in terms of subsections (1) and (2) of section 49 of the Natural Resources Act [Chapter 150], that the Minister of Environment and Tourism intends to divide the

Vuti Intensive Conservation area in Hurungwe District into two separate intensive conservation areas namely Vuti and Vuti "F".

Any holder of land affected by the proposed division of the Intensive Conservation Area who objects to the division is called upon to lodge, in writing, within 30 days of publication of this notice, at the office of the Secretary for Environment and Tourism, Private Bag 7753, Causeway, his objections together with a full statement of the grounds for such objections.

INCOME TAX [CHAPTER 181]

Exemption from Non-Residents' Tax on Interest

THE Senior Minister of Finance, Economic Planning and Development, in terms of subparagraph (iv) of paragraph (a) of the definition of "interest" in subparagraph (1) of paragraph 1 of the Sixteenth Schedule to the Income Tax Act [Chapter 181], hereby specifies the Agricultural Marketing Authority in respect of interest payable by the Authority on the loan entered between the Authority and a consortium of banks with ANZ (Australia and New Zealand Banking Group) London as the agent bank on the 26th June, 1992. The loan is guaranteed by the Government of Zimbabwe for US\$65 million.

The consequence of this specification is that the interest payable on the said loan is exempt from non-residents' tax on interest.

Conditions for Acceptance of Copy

FAILURE to comply with any of the following conditions will result in the rejection of copy, and no responsibility can be accepted if such rejection should affect any date contained in such copy or any requirement of publication on a specific date.

Persons drafting any kind of notices are strongly advised to follow the guidance offered in—

- the Instructions Relating to the Drafting and Typing of Legislation (Attorney-General's Circular 1 of 1978); and
- the Manual of Style for the Drafting and Preparation of Copy, published by the Department of Printing and Stationery;

which two booklets are intended for complementary use.

In these conditions, other than where a particular kind of copy is specified, "copy" means copy for all matter contained in the *Gazette* itself and for subsidiary legislation issued as supplements to the *Gazette*.

1. (1) Other than by prior arrangements, only original typing is accepted.

(2) Carbon-copies are not normally acceptable, other than in cases where the original typing has to be legally retained, elsewhere, as, for example, in the case of a proclamation.

(3) Computer print-outs are not accepted automatically, as discussion may be necessary with regard to the extra time and costs involved.
