Exclusive Prospecting Order No. 851: Harare and Gweru Mining Districts

THE following order is published in terms of subsection (2) of section 92 of the Mines and Minerals Act [Chapter 165]:—

"I, Eddison Jonas Mudairwa Zvobgo, Minister of Mines, with the approval of the President, hereby, in terms of subsection (1) of section 92 of the Mines and Minerals Act [Chapter 165], make an exclusive prospecting order, in favour of Somabula Ventures (Private) Limited, over the area described hereunder, in the Harare and Gweru mining districts in relation to maps references St. Michael's Mission 1830 D2, Featherstone 1830 D2, Mwenezi Poort 1830 D3 and St. Mark's School 1830 D4, all of the Second Edition and all of the scale 1:50 000, produced by the Surveyor-General, subject to the following conditions—
