ROAD MOTOR TRANSPORTATION ACT [CHAPTER 262]

Notice of Intention to Authorize Carriage and Haulage of Goods without Road Service Permit

THE Minister of Transport and Energy hereby gives notice, in terms of subsection (2) of section 30 of the Road Motor Transportation Act [Chapter 262], of his intention to declare that, until the 31st December, 1997, the carriage or haulage of general goods and merchandise for hire or reward within Zimbabwe by vehicles or trailers or combinations thereof of not more than 10 tonnes carrying capacity, which are roadworthy and registered in Zimbabwe, shall be lawful although no road service permits exist in respect of such carriage or haulage.

Any person who objects to such a declaration is called upon to lodge his objections, in writing, with the Secretary for Transport and Energy, Thirteenth Floor, Kaguvu Building, Fourth Street, Harare, or Private Bag 7710, Causeway, within 21 days after the date of publication of this notice.

PROCUREMENT OF DRUGS

1. The Government of Zimbabwe has received a credit from the World Bank (hereinafter called "the credit") and intends to apply part of the proceeds of this credit to eligible payments under the contract for the supply of the goods covered by this invitation for bids (IFB).
2. The Government Medical Stores, acting on behalf of the Ministry of Health & Child Welfare (hereinafter described as "the purchaser"), hereby invites sealed bids from primary manufacturers or their authorized representatives from member countries of the World Bank for the supply of the drugs generally described on line 3 of the ITB data sheet and listed in detail in the Schedule of Requirements. A "primary manufacturer" is defined as a company that performs all the manufacturing and fabricating operations needed to produce the drugs in their appropriate forms, sizes, packing, labelling and quality-testing. Bids may be submitted by an authorized agent for and on behalf of the primary manufacturer provided the bid is accompanied by a duly notarized letter of authority from the primary manufacturer authorizing the designated agent to bid for and on behalf of the primary manufacturer. Prepackers, shippers, merchant exporters and traders are not classified as primary manufacturer and bids from them will not be accepted.
3. Bidders are free to quote for any or all of the items listed in the Schedule of Requirements and the evaluation of bids will be conducted on a per item basis. A margin of preference will be granted to drugs meeting all the requirements of the bidding documents which are manufactured in Zimbabwe in accordance with instructions to bidders (ITB) clause 27.
4. Documentary evidence will be required of all bidders that they have qualifications, experience and capacity to be able to successfully complete the contract on time for the drugs offered.
5. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from, and inspect the bidding documents at the purchaser's office given on line 2 of the ITB data sheet.
6. A complete set of the bidding documents may be obtained from the purchaser at the address listed on line 2 of the ITB data sheet on submission of a written application and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of USD 40 (United States Dollars, Forty) or the equivalent in Zimbabwean dollars. All payments will be by bank draft or certified bank cheque made out in favour of the purchaser.
7. All bids must be accompanied by a bid security in the amount of not less than (two) 2 per cent. of the bid amount with a minimum value of not less than USD 10 000, either in the bid currency or in Zimbabwe dollars.
8. The deadline for the submission of bids is 21st March, 1996, bids received after that date and time will not be accepted. Bids will be opened at the Zimbabwe Government Tender Board (G.T.B.) shortly after the specified deadline in the presence of bidders' representatives who choose to attend at 1000 hours on 21st March, 1996.

Conditions of Acceptance of Copy

FAILURE to comply with any of the following conditions will result in the rejection of copy, and no responsibility can be accepted if such rejection should affect any date contained in such copy or any requirement of publication on a specific date.

Persons drafting any kind of notices are strongly advised to follow the guidance offered in—

- the Instructions Relating to the Drafting and Typing of Legislation (Attorney-General's Circular 1 of 1978); and
- the Manual of Style for the Drafting and Preparation of copy published by the Department of Printing and Stationery;

which two booklets are intended for complementary use.

In these conditions, other than where a particular kind of copy is specified, "copy" means copy for all matter contained in the *Gazette* itself and for subsidiary legislation issued as supplements to the *Gazette*.

1. (1) Other than by prior arrangements, only original typing is accepted.

(2) Carbon-copies are not normally acceptable, other than in cases where the original typing has to be legally retained, elsewhere, as, for example, in the case of a proclamation.

(3) Computer print-outs are not accepted automatically, as discussion may be necessary with regard to the extra time and costs involved.

2. (1) All copy must be clear and legible, and there must be double or one and a half spacing between the lines.

(2) Any corrections or alterations made by the originator, must be clearly effected in blue or black ink, using editorial marks—not proof-reader's marks:

Provided that any copy containing extensive alterations will be rejected.

3. (1) Copy must appear on one side only of each sheet of paper.

(2) Except as is provided in subsection (2) of section 8, paper must not exceed 210 millimetres in width.

(3) If copy comprises two or more sheets of paper, all sheets must be numbered consecutively, in arabic figures, preferably in the top right-hand corner.

(4) Where any matter is added after the copy has been prepared, and such additional matter results in one or more sheets being inserted between those already numbered, all sheets must be renumbered from there onwards—not, for instance 7, 7b, 8, *et cetera*.

4. Photographic copy or copy produced on a duplicating machine may be accepted if it is abundantly clear.

5. (1) Should any copy—

- (a) exceed 10 pages of double-spaced typing on size A4 paper; or
- (b) contain tabular or other matter which involves complicated setting;

it will be classed as "lengthy" copy, and will be required to be submitted not less than 21 days before the date of closing for the *Gazette* in which it is to be published.

(2) Lengthy copy may be accepted at less than 21 days' notice if—

- (a) the work involved is of a straight forward and non-tabular nature; and
