ROAD MOTOR TRANSPORTATION ACT [CHAPTER 262]

Applications in Connexion with Road Service Permits

Interim Statement

ECONOMIC OVERVIEW

Growth in the economy was generally weak during the first half of the 1995/96 financial year, due largely increases in inflation, which averaged about 26%, the effect of the 1994/95 drought on domestic demand, poor export performance and stiff competition from imports

As a result of the drought which depressed output in the agricultural sector (with the exception of the tobacco subsector and the horticultural sector) output in the manufacturing sector declined significantly during the period under review. Hardest hit was the textile sector which registered a drop of over 50% in production.

The strong growth of 10% recorded in the mining sector in 1995 was underpinned by the firm international base mineral prices. International gold prices increased by 3,4% in the six month period to March, 1996, compared to the corresponding period in 1995.

The high inflation rate resulted in high money market interest rates, with the benchmark NCD rate increasing from 27,5% in October, 1995, to 30% by March, 1996. In view of this, lending rates ranged between 32% and 39%. Consequently, a large number of firms, both large and small, were severely affected by the high cost of funds. Inevitably, some firms faced liquidation where it became apparent that there was virtually no prospect for recovery. Other firms restructured and concentrated on their core businesses and/or disposed of non-core activities in order to release cash into their operations. Thus, in spite of the improved forecast in the performance of the economy generally as a result of the good rainy season, there will still be a large overhang of debt in a number of companies which will constrain growth.

GROUP RESTRUCTURING

Shareholders may be aware that FINHOLD is being assisted by an internationally renowned consultancy firm, Andersen Consulting to reposition the Group in order to achieve greater market focus while minimising structural inefficiencies, for competitive advantage.

The re-engineering exercise includes market research on both customers and non-customers to ensure that the Group is aligned to market expectations. All key process are being reviewed in order to reduce administrative time, improve on the market interface and focus alteration on effective debt collection.

During the period under review a high level structure was developed and approved by the Board which will reduce the number of operating business units from three to two, the Retail Bank and the Corporate Bank. These units will be supported by two specialist units, the Finance and Risk Management Division and the Corporate Services Division.

The Retail Bank will operate under the trade name Zimbank and focus primarily on the individual market requirements. The Corporate Bank which will trade as Syfrets Corporate and Merchant Bank will focus on relationship banking to that segment of the market. Within Corporate Services, emphasis is being placed on the future role of Information Systems. Further, investment in technology is envisaged to ensure that the operating business units are appropriately positioned for competitive advantage. New Product development is also a key responsibility in this supporting unit.

Finance and the Risk Management Division will be responsible for the management of risk through the Treasury and Group Credit Units. A major departure from the current structure will be the establishment of a Group Credit and Risk Management unit within Finance and Risk Management Division, totally independent of the operating business units in order to improve credit risk management and recovery. These supporting infrastructures have been instituted in the current structure in order to minimise losses and improve recoveries.

An essential component of the restructuring exercise is the increased emphasis being placed on collection of bad debts and rehabilitation of advances where there are prospects of viability. Further, a number of initiatives to release funds from non-core business areas in the Group are being implemented.

It is encouraging to report that agreement has now been reached, in principle, on how to address the under-capitalisation of the Group, taking into account the constraints on the major shareholder. In the meantime, the Group has received some assistance from the Authorities to enable it to trade out of its current difficulties. In addition, the \$300 million guarantee issued to Zimbank remains in place.

The review exercise is continuing and the full organisational structure is to be finalised by July, 1996, with the implementation planned for October, 1996. It is anticipated that all the above measures will place the Group on a stronger financial base.

GROUP RESULTS

Despite the prevailing difficult economic and financial environment the Group's total income, for the half year, of \$243 million is 10,1% or \$22,218 million above the figure for the same period in the previous year. Net income for the period under review is \$32,475 million compared with \$28,020 million in the corresponding period in 1995, representing a 15,9% increase. Zimbank's contribution to the Group's profit is \$6 million.

For the balance of the financial year the economy is set to benefit from the current good agricultural season. However, the negative effects of previous successive droughts will be difficult to offset in one season. Nevertheless the Group forecasts a much better performance in the second half of the year.

Divident Announcement

Directors consider it prudent to transfer significant amounts to reserves and have, accordingly, declared an interim dividend for the six months ended 31st March, 1996 of \$5 011 000 (1995: \$5 007 000). This equates to 20,0 cents (1995: 20,0 cents) per share payable to shareholders registered in the books of the Company at the close of business on Friday 17th May, 1996. This dividend is 6.48 times covered.

The transfer books and the register of members will be closed from 18th May, 1996 to 20th May, 1996, both days inclusive. Dividend cheques will be posted to shareholders on or about 28th May, 1996. Shareholders' tax will be deducted at the rate of 15% where applicable.
