IT is hereby notified, for general information, that it is necessary to draw attention to the "Conditions for Acceptance of Copy", which appears in every issue of the *Gazette*; and particularly the need to submit lengthy copy, in the case of Statutory Instruments, at least 21 days before the date of closing for the *Gazette* in which the notice is to be published.

During the past few months or so there have been many cases where urgent copy for subsidiary legislation, which requires the signature of the President or a minister to give it effect, and which is of national importance, has been sent in for publication in the Gazette after closing-time. Whilst I acknowledge that it is the duty of the Department of Printing and Stationery to give certain notices special treatment, I am, however, of the view that a Gazette Extraordinary has tended to be a must rather than a matter of priority in respect of unwarranted delays of pagent copy.

While every effort will continue to be made to publish Extraordinaries on the required dates, copy must be submitted timeously so that it can be programmed into the printing-work-flow as soon as it is available.
