The Reserve Bank took this action upon determining that ReNaissance Merchant Bank is not in a sound financial condition. In particular the unsafe and unsound condition of ReNaissance Merchant Bank is attributable to inadequate capitalization, poor corporate governance practices and internal controls, high level of non-performing insider and related party exposures, chronic liquidity and income generation challenges as well as violation of banking laws and regulations.

The primary purpose of the curatorship is to protect depositors, preserve the assets of the ReNaissance Merchant Bank and protect the stability of the financial system.

One of the consequences of placing ReNaissance Merchant Bank under the management of a curator is that the institution of all legal proceedings and the execution of writs, warrants, summons, etc. is now stayed unless the High Court otherwise grants leave. Another consequence is to suspend the powers of every director, officer and shareholder of ReNaissance Merchant Bank, except to the extent that the curator may permit them to exercise such powers.

Members of the public are advised that ReNaissance Merchant Bank will remain open to the banking public as the institution will continue to provide financial services at the discretion of the curator. The curator will take over and assume the management of ReNaissance Merchant Bank in such a manner as he considers prudent and most likely to promote the interests of the institution, its depositors and creditors.

- (a) the Instructions Relating to the Drafting and Typing of Legislation (Attorney-General's Circular 1 of 1978); and
- (b) the Manual of Style for the Drafting and Preparation of copy published by Printflow (Private) Limited;

which two booklets are intended for complementary use.

In these conditions, other than where a particular kind of copy is specified, "copy" means copy for all matter contained in the *Gazette* itself and for subsidiary legislation issued as supplements to the *Gazette*.
