- 2. The First Schedule to the Broadcasting Services (Licensing and Content) Regulations, 2004, published in Statutory Instrument 185 of 2004 ("hereinafter called the principal regulations"), is amended as follows
 - (a) by the repeal of paragraphs 5, 6, 11 and 12;
 - (b) by the deletion of "10" in paragraph 13 and substitution with "15":
 - (c) by the insertion of the following in paragraph 13(b) "The business plan including details of tariff to be charged and justification thereof.".

Broadcasting Services (Community and Campus Radio Broadcasting Services) (Amendment) Regulations, 2020 (No. 1)

- 2. Section 2 of the Broadcasting Services (Community and Campus Radio Broadcasting Services) Regulations, 2020, published in Statutory Instrument 39 of 2020 ("hereinafter called the principal regulations"), is amended by the insertion of the following definition—
 - ""board corporate" means a company registered in terms of Companies and Other Business Entities Act [Chapter 24:31], or any legally recognised group of people constituted through an association, trust or any other legal entity identified by a particular name and capable of suing or being sued in its own name but excludes a natural person;".
