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299. Constitution: Amendment of Proclamation 2 of 2020.	

[CONSTITUTION

Amendment of Proclamation 2 of 2020

Proclamation 2 of 2020, published in Statutory Instrument 151 of 2020, is amended as follows—

- (a) by the deletion of “HONOURABLE” in the preamble;
- (b) by the deletion of “section 4(1)(a) to (k)” and substituted with the following—

“4.(1) The Institute shall be governed by a nine-member Board of Governors appointed by the Minister, consisting of—

- (a) one member well versed in human resources management in the public sector;
- (b) one Diplomat;
- (c) one member from the academia selected on the basis of their knowledge and expertise in the areas of Diplomacy and International Relations;
- (d) one member appointed from the tourism and hospitality sector;
- (e) one member appointed from industry and commerce or investment facilitation sectors;
- (f) three members appointed on the basis of their qualifications, diverse knowledge and skills in areas that contributed to the advancement of the country’s foreign policy interest; and
- (g) the Director-General of the Zimbabwe Foreign Service Institute, who shall be the Secretary and *ex-officio* member of the Board.”.
